The Toddler-Adult Program is designed for children (age two by October 1st) and parents/caregivers to interact with each other and their teacher in a comfortable nurturing classroom environment. A certified teacher will guide children and adults as they experience play, art, music, group activities, and story time. Adults also have the opportunity to discuss parenting issues, which are so common and yet so challenging, as they develop a growing appreciation of each child's unique developmental milestones. Our nurturing and warm atmosphere supports children's cognitive, physical, social, and emotional development, serving as the first gentle step into the Sayre Preschool experience and environment. Facilitated by a certified teacher and accompanying Fine Arts teachers and professionals, this program accommodates a maximum of 8 children and their adults.
