Aaron moved to Los Angeles with the intention of pursuing a journalism career, but instead found success as a standup comedian. After appearing on shows such as "**According to Jim**," Aaron moved behind the camera, creating two comedy series for MTV and serving as Head Writer of the **Comedy Central Roast** specials. This led to his work as a writer-producer for the Fox animated sitcom "**The Cleveland Show**" and NBC's "**The New Normal**."

Currently, Aaron serves as Co-Executive Producer of "**Family Guy**" and develops new programming as part of his overall deal with 20th Century Fox. He lives in Pasadena, CA with his wife and two children.
