

Spectator Policy

Revised March 5, 2021

Sayre School has announced an updated spectator policy for their spring home events that will allow a limited number of guests to attend, which will come into effect on March 13, 2021.

In conjunction with the Kentucky High School Athletic Association (KHSAA) and its member schools, Sayre looks to establish safe guidelines for reopening gates to allow a limited number of spectators, as other schools and sport venues currently do across the country.

In order to limit the number of outside visitors to campus, each Sayre student-athlete is limited to four guests at each home competition who are legally or emotionally related to them. Visiting team players are allowed two fans per contest.

All guests must follow all Safe at Sayre guidelines while in attendance, including wearing masks or face coverings at all times covering the nose and mouth, and maintaining six feet social distancing. Guests are permitted to eat or drink at contests, but are asked to keep masks on when not eating or drinking.

Guests must also follow Sayre's seating policy and arrangements in order to maintain six feet distance to others, and may not interact with student-athletes while at the contest, remaining at least 12 feet from all student-athletes and all competition areas. Sayre strictly prohibits large groups gathering at games, and requires all guests to depart immediately following the conclusion of the event.

Sayre and the athletic department hold the right to adjust their attendance policy based on the current conditions regarding the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.
